LEVEL 3 EARLY YEARS APPRENTICESHIP OVERVIEW

The Level 3 Early Years Apprenticeship standard is to provide high quality early education and care to children in a range of childcare settings. Suitable for Early Years Workers, Deputy Managers or Owners.

Key Apprenticeship information

Level: 3

Course type: Apprenticeship

Duration: 8- 18 Months (including End point Assessment)

End-point assessment organisation: TQUK

Certification: Level 3 Early Years Educator, Level 2 Functional Skills English (if not exempt).

Cost per apprenticeship: Non-levy employer contribution (5%) - £350 / or Private payment: £2,600

Cost per apprenticeship + Montessori Diploma: Non-levy employer contribution (5%) - £350 plus £1,500 / or Private payment: £4,450

Entry Requirements

- In paid employment (Working for a minimum of 16 hours per week)
- Have lived in the UK or EEA/EU for the last 3+years (With a valid form of ID)
- Not be using any other government funding (College, University or online training courses)
- 16-18 year-olds, if they do not have GCSE English & Maths grade C/4 or Functional Skills equivalent, will be required to study L2 Functional Skills English & Maths.
- 19+ year olds, if they do not have GCSE English grade C/4 or Functional Skills equivalent, will be able to study to gain L2 Functional Skills English (EYFS qualification requirement).
- Will require a valid EYFS-recognised Paediatric First Aid certificate for EPA gateway.
- Be able to commit to the full course duration and meet the programme modules through your job role

How to support child development

The Early Years Educator Level 3 Apprenticeship is made up of several themes which develop the practitioner's knowledge, skills and behaviour. Undertaking this apprenticeship will develop the practitioner's ability to reflect and understand the underpinning policies, procedures and theories in early years practice to become a competent and professional Level 3 Early Years Educator.

The programme is spread across 18 months and covers 12 units across 7 themes:



Health, Safety & Wellbeing of Children

Physical care, promoting healthy lifestyles, risk assessments, legislation & guidance for H&S in a childcare setting.



Communication with Children

Supporting numeracy & literacy development. Promoting positive behaviour, supporting children through transitions, identifying children's needs, equality, diversity inclusion.



Role of Practitioner

Personal development plans, understanding your role and the importance of reflective practice.



Understanding Child Development

Theory and philosophical approaches, supporting children's communication, holistic development and ensuring the EYFS requirements are met.



Safeguarding in a Childcare setting

Understanding legislation, guidelines, policies and procedures for safeguarding within the Early Year setting.



Working in Partnership

Understanding the principles of partnership working in relation to current frameworks.



Working with additional needs

Understanding the role of early intervention in supporting children with additional support needs.

WHAT WILL I LEARN DURING THE MONTESSORI DIPLOMA?

The course is split into several modules:

- What Is Montessori?
- Practical Life
- Sensorial
- Mathematics
- Language
- Cultural

There are various assignments for each module and throughout the course.

Assignments within the programme vary in style:

- Online tests
- Written assignments

After completing each module, you will be given an online test and a written assignment, which will be marked and returned by your dedicated mentor.



THE BINOMIAL CUBE

MATERIAL
A cube composed of 8 wooden blocks, which fit together in a binomial pattern, representing two algebraic relationships $(a+b)^3$.

PRESENTATION
This is a sensorial presentation, the child works with the cube as a puzzle, and they will learn that formula at a much later stage.
Take the box to the table, open the box and place the lid in front of the child; the lid has a picture of the binomial cube.
Remove the pieces of the binomial cube and place in two lines as in photo. You can show the child that each line is of the same height by placing your hand across the line. Then place pieces onto the box lid showing the child that the sizes are the same and the colours match.
Continue with the second layer, pause and then the pieces can be returned to the box, ready for the child to use.

EXERCISES
The child completes the exercise as shown. At a later stage, they can be shown the layout for the binomial cube.

PURPOSE
To learn about three dimensional shapes and patterns in Mathematics. Indirect preparation for algebra.

VOCABULARY
At a later stage the child can name the pieces in the cube.

As an Apprentice, you will be working alongside qualified staff in your early years setting and you will have a dedicated, highly experienced Development Coach who will visit you in your nursery providing teaching and learning, assessing your work and feedback on your progress and vital guidance on how you can improve.



Off the Job Training

Off-the-Job training includes training that is delivered during the apprentice's normal place of work. The aim is to develop their knowledge, skills and behaviours in their role. but must not be delivered as part of their normal working duties. This can include: online teaching, in-house training, workplace assessments, digital learning resources and one-on-one tuition.



Independent Learning

Your Development Coach will guide you and will use a range of assessment methods to gather evidence of your developing skills, knowledge and behaviours including; face to face observations, employer observations, assignment work, independent study and research, case studies, videos, professional discussions and question and answers.

Apparatus Workshop

You will also attend a 10 day workshop.

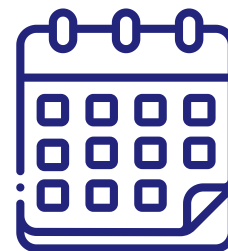

END POINT ASSESSMENT (EPA)



The End-point assessment is an independent synoptic assessment of the knowledge, skills and behaviours which have been learnt throughout the apprenticeship and tests the apprentice's ability to apply them in the workplace.

After successful delivery of the programme, You will be able to enter the Gateway to take your End-Point Assessment (EPA).

The EPA for this standard is made up of two assessment methods (supported by a portfolio of work):

Observation of Practice

- Prepare a Teacher Pack to support an observation with question and answer with Independent End-Point Assessor.

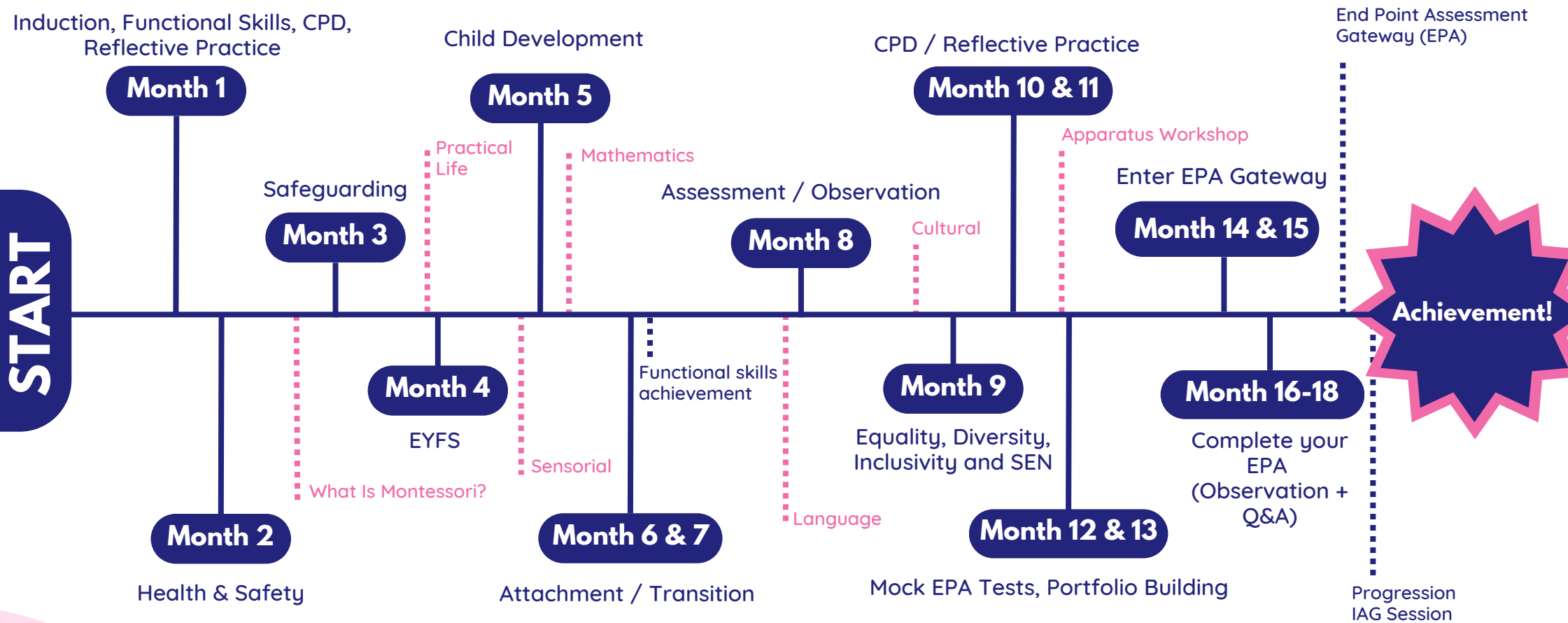
Professional Discussion (90 minute duration) Underpinned by a portfolio of work

- Grading of pass, distinction or fail depending on MCQ result
- Test knowledge, skills and behaviours you have learnt during your diploma
- Any failed criteria will require a resit

Assessments are conducted by TQUK an approved independent End-Point Assessment Organisation.

APPRENTICESHIP PAYMENT & FUNDING

This apprenticeship costs £7,000 and is funded by both the employer and the government. The government will pay 95% (£6,650) of the cost. The remaining 5% (£350) will be paid at the start of the apprenticeship.

The Montessori Diploma element will be privately funded. Our Montessori Diploma costs £1,500 when combined with the Level 3 Early Years Educator Apprenticeship.

How do I apply for funding?

If you are eligible for government funding it is quick and easy to set up an apprenticeship account on the government website.
